One of the highlights of the week was the 'Innovative STEM Expo', where students showcased their projects from STEM classes, participated in the Green Design Challenge, displayed sculptures made from recycled materials and performed various science experiments as Jr. Scientists. The creativity and innovation on display were truly inspiring. Students from senior classes visited Galgotia College. They learned about all aspects of spacecraft and the science behind space exploration. Students from 9th grade organized a workshop on bioenzymes. They promoted alternatives to everyday chemicals like fertilizers, pesticides, and all-purpose cleaners. Students learned to prepare bio-enzymes using just three ingredients: flower petals, orange peels, jaggery, and water. Students in 10th grade organized a Sustainable Food Festival. They showcased dishes made from local biodiversity, including roasted makhana, makhana shake, chia seed smoothies, tulsi seed tea, yam pomegranate pudding, almond gum, coconut, ajwain leaf pakoras, ajwain tea, peepal herbal tea, kokam juice, and gulab sharbat.10th-grade students visited Yatharth Hospital.
